**1301:3-2-10**      **Temporary plumbing inspector certificate for members of the military and their spouses.**

- (A) "Military duty" has the same meaning as set forth in division (A) of section 4743.041 of the Revised Code.
- (B) Pursuant to section 4743.041 of the Revised Code, the superintendent shall issue a temporary plumbing inspector certificate to an individual, provided that the individual demonstrates to the satisfaction of the superintendent that all of the following qualifications are met:
- (1) The individual holds a valid license or certificate to perform plumbing inspections issued by any other state or jurisdiction;
  - (2) The individual is in, and certifies that the individual is in, good standing with and not under investigation by the other state or jurisdiction that issued to the individual a valid license or certificate to perform plumbing inspections; and
  - (3) The individual presents adequate proof that the individual or the individual's spouse is on military duty in this state.
- (C) An application for a temporary plumbing inspector certificate must be made in writing to the superintendent on a form prescribed and furnished by the superintendent.
- (D) A temporary plumbing inspector certificate is valid for a period of six years, unless revoked or suspended.
- (E) A temporary plumbing inspector certificate issued under this rule cannot be renewed.
