



Ohio H.B. 199 - MLO License Certificate Update

Effective November 1, the Division of Financial Institutions will no longer provide individual PDF certificates to Mortgage Loan Originators (MLOs) upon the issuance or renewal of a MLO license. At the same time, the division will no longer require MLOs to maintain and display physical license certificates to the public.

Instead, MLOs and the public can obtain current licensing information on the Nationwide Multistate Licensing System (NMLS) Consumer Access database, available [here](#).

If needed, the division may clarify these requirements and obtain feedback from interested parties in the context of an administrative rule-making process. At this time, please feel free to provide any feedback or concerns to the division at webdfi-cf@com.state.oh.us.

MLOs applying for renewal of a license for 2019 should be aware they will not receive a PDF certificate from the division as in prior years upon approval of a renewal. Rather, the email notification sent by NMLS and the updated information in NMLS will provide notification concerning the division's approval of a MLO license renewal. The division will not provide an individual PDF certificate upon request.
