Paul currently serves as President of the Meigs County Community Improvement Corporation, is the Vice Chairman of the Board of Trustees of Rio Grande Community College in Rio Grande, Ohio, and is a member of the board of directors of Holzer Health Systems in Gallipolis, Ohio.
