Stephen H. Jenkins is a senior vice president at the Federal Reserve Bank of Cleveland. He is responsible for the Bank's Supervision and Regulation Department, which oversees more than 275 financial institutions in the Fourth Federal Reserve District, which includes Ohio, western Pennsylvania, eastern Kentucky, and the northern panhandle of West Virginia. He also has responsibility for the Bank's Credit Risk Management and Statistics and Analysis departments.

Mr. Jenkins joined the Supervision and Regulation Department in 1986 as a bank examiner. He was appointed assistant vice president in 1996, vice president in 1999, and to his current position in 2007.

A native of Cleveland, Mr. Jenkins holds a bachelor's degree in Finance from Bowling Green State University, an MBA from the University of Pittsburgh, and a degree from the Graduate School of Banking at the University of Colorado.
