



BUSTR Class C Operator Training Form

Instructional Material, Evaluation and Certification

Rule 1301:7-9-19 of the Ohio Administrative Code requires owners of underground storage tank (UST) systems to identify and train Class C operators for their facilities. Class C operators are responsible for the initial response to alarms or other indications of emergencies at a facility. All Class C operators shall complete this form before assuming responsibilities as a Class C operator. Owners shall maintain this form and make it available to the state fire marshal upon request. No passing score is necessary to meet the requirements of this form.

Class C operators shall complete the following questions. If a question is not applicable, mark 'NA' and provide an explanation at the bottom of the form.	Yes	No	NA
1) Have you received training identifying the telephone number to call the fire department for this facility and is this number posted in a clearly visible location?			
2) Have you received training identifying the list of company people who should be notified in an emergency and is this list posted in a clearly visible location?			
3) Have you received training identifying the actions to take concerning the emergency shut off switch? <small>NOTE: The emergency shut off switch shuts off power to all the dispensers and fuel pumps. The emergency shut off switch is different from the "Stop" or "All Stop" button on the point-of-sale (POS) console. The emergency stop switch is required by national fire codes. Contact a qualified petroleum storage system service contractor if you cannot locate the emergency shut off switch.</small>			
4) Have you received training identifying how to respond to various alarm messages that may appear on the display of the tank monitoring system? <small>Note: If you do not know how to read the display or what messages to expect if there is a problem with the storage system, look in the tank monitor manual to find this information or call a qualified petroleum system contractor and have him or her explain this information to you.</small>			
5) Have you received training identifying how to locate and properly recognize the dispensing unit components? For example, the dispenser, hose, nozzle and breakaway coupling.
