CHANGE OF BUSINESS ADDRESS

Per Ohio Revised Code 4735.13(D), in case of any change of business location, a principal broker shall give notice to the superintendent, on a form prescribed by the superintendent, within thirty days after the change of location, whereupon the superintendent shall issue new licenses for the unexpired period without charge. If a broker changes a business location without giving the required notice and without receiving new licenses that action is prima-facie evidence of misconduct under division (A)(6) of Section 4735.18.

This form is interactive. You may, before printing, type your responses directly onto the form. Otherwise, this form must be typewritten or printed legibly in black ink.

- The company/broker original license must be returned with this application in order for the request to be processed.
Incomplete or incorrect applications will be returned for correction.
