

SOGG SETTLEMENT – CURRENT ADDRESS NEEDED TO PAY INTEREST

If you or a family member received unclaimed funds from the State of Ohio between August 3, 2000 and October 9, 2012, you may be due additional money. A class action has ordered interest to be paid, over and above the return of unclaimed funds owned by successful claimants.

But, the settlement administrator, Strategic Claims Services, must know how to reach you if you are due more money. If the Settlement Administrator has your current address because you have not moved since you were paid the unclaimed funds, or because you already provided your updated information, you will be mailed a check if you are entitled to interest.

But, the settlement administrator has not been able to locate many people who may be due money because their current address is unknown. If you are among the persons with unknown addresses, the settlement administrator needs your current contact information.
